Curriculum News

Maths Focus

This term, Year 9 students have been developing their understanding of financial mathematics in lessons. They have explored key real-life concepts such as taxation, budgeting, and bank accounts, including calculating income tax and VAT, as well as gaining an introduction to mortgages and loans. These topics help students build essential life skills that will support them well beyond the classroom.

Later this month, students in Years 9, 10, and 11 will have the opportunity to take part in the Intermediate Maths Challenge. This national competition encourages students to think creatively, tackle complex problems, and apply their mathematical knowledge in unfamiliar and engaging ways. It is an excellent opportunity for students to stretch their problem-solving skills and build confidence.

We also offer a lunchtime enrichment club, Maths Circle, for students who enjoy exploring mathematics beyond their regular lessons. One Year 12 student describes the club as: “Maths Circle is a fun and engaging club where we apply our maths and reasoning skills to challenging real-world and hypothetical problems. These problems are highly rewarding and satisfying to solve, whilst also encouraging us to think in new ways that are not normally taught within lessons.”

They meet in B03 every Wednesday lunchtime, all years are welcome from Yr 7 through to Yr 13, please bring your lunch with you.

For any student worrying about their homework, or may have missed a lesson or two we also run a catch up club in B02 every Wednesday lunchtime where students can come and work on their homework or ask questions about anything they may be unsure of in Maths.

And finally, as Year 11 prepare for their next set of mocks at the end of this term, Maths Revision guides will be available to purchase on MCAS from Mon 19th January, with the deadline for orders Mon 26th January.
