


Take a walk into town and get the Bimmelbahn to the Zoo Take Bimmelbahn back to town, time for shopping and lunch

IMPORTANT POST-BREXIT INFORMATION

The UK has now left the European Union and there are some changes to the rules for UK citizens travelling to the EU, Iceland, Switzerland, Norway or Liechtenstein.

PASSPORTS

On the day you travel, all UK passports must have 6 months of validity left and be less than 10 years old (even if it has 6 months or more left)*

*Please note that this does not apply to Ireland - you can continue to use your passport as long as it is valid for the duration of your stay.

HEALTHCARE

If you have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) you can continue to use this until it expires. If you do not have an EHIC or it has expired, you can apply for a Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC).
